After presentation of your construction documents to the North Pond Task Force, one of the task force members noticed there were some subtle differences which had not been approved by the Lincoln Park Advisory Council. It appears that there are two "wings" built out on each side of the original building (one on the north side designated as a coat room and another one on the south side with no designation but the existing door on that side now leads to the kitchen). This is in addition to the enclosure of the outdoor seating area (and does not attach to it in any way). LPAC approved of the enclosure of the outdoor seating area only and would like to request that you bring your construction documents to our planning committee which is held the first Thursday of each month. I would like to encourage you to contact our Vice President, and Planning Committee Task Force Chair, Gary Sinclair to schedule your presentation (773-871-4389). Since we will not have informed you in time to make the July meeting Gary may call a special meeting to address this issue.
